ENTRY FEES	<p> BSSF members £28.40 for each class entered (You will need your membership number to hand) Non - members £37.80 for each class entered Junior entries £16.50 for members £22 non-members Recreational class (Sat only) £1 per dog enter on the day Please note that if you enter more than one class, whilst we will try to accommodate this in the start lists, we cannot guarantee there will be enough time for you to get round in time. As the second day's starts are seeded based on the results on day one, we cannot alter these to accommodate you so please bear this in mind. </p>
ENTRIES	<p>All entries are via our online system at www. bookitzone.com</p>
CLOSING DATE	<p>Entries close MIDDAY 04/01/2019 – no late entries will be accepted.</p>
DIRECTIONS	<p> Directions, Site is open from 12:00 (mid-day) Friday. From A14: Take the A12 North (signed Lowestoft). After 7 miles, at roundabout, turn right, (signed Bawdsey B1152 and Rendlesham Forest Centre). Keep on this road for approximately 2 miles and then turn left at the roundabout following Orford B1084. Stay on B1084 for approximately 4 miles. Entrance to the forest will be signposted on the right. </p>
TRAIL DESCRIPTION	<p> Rendlesham Forest offers grass and sand trails with short crossover sections of rounded pebbles. The terrain is gently undulating. </p>
TRAIL DISTANCE	<p> All classes (including DR4J) 3.5 miles +/- approx. Juniors (11-14 years) 2 mile +/- approx. 1 Mile +/- for younger junior age groups </p>
AGES – DOGS & DRIVERS	<p> The age of the athlete is taken from the age the athlete will be on the 31st of December at the end of that racing season, this age will be the athlete's age for that full racing season. The age of a dog will be 18 months old for scooter and bikejor and 12 months old for all other classes from the first day of the race. (Please note if you enter DS2 with a rig your dogs MUST be 18 months old) </p>

WORLD CUP POINTS	<p>Drivers with DID numbers will be eligible to gain World Cup points at this race. Where necessary results of classes will be combined to give the relevant results. Please note you need to apply for a DID by 20th December at the latest to allow time for the IFSS to issue one in time for this race. (DID numbers are published on the IFSS website when issued.)</p>

START TIMES	<p>09:00 Saturday, 8:00 Sunday (Subject to change, but will NOT be earlier)</p>

Course inspection:

Course inspection on foot or bicycle is allowed on Friday evening and Saturday morning before the competitors meeting.

Stakeout/campsite:

Loose dogs are not allowed on the campsite or stakeout at any time. Please keep all dogs on leads.

RNB:

RNB means Siberian Husky, Alaskan Malamute, Canadian Eskimo Dog, Greenland Dog or Samoyed. All RNB dogs must have the appropriate Kennel Club registration paperwork which you must bring to registration as evidence.

Vaccinations:

All Dogs must be vaccinated in accordance with IFSS rules and you must bring evidence of this to registration

Borrowed Dogs:

If you are borrowing dogs, you must have written consent from the owner.

Insurance:

You must hold adequate insurance to race and evidence of this must be brought to registration please.
