

IPC Approved Parallel Success Competition in the Leicestershire & Rutland and Warwickshire County *Track & Field* Championships at the Pingles Stadium, Nuneaton, CV11 4LX Saturday 23rd and Sunday 24th May 2015

Terms and conditions

It is a condition of entry that you read this prospectus and accept the conditions in it. The Competition is held under UKA Rules, IPC Rules and the Rules of the local County Athletics Associations.

Parallel Success

Disability athletics events have been promoted and included in our Championships for a number of years, but this is the fourth year that the County Championships have been recognised by UKA as part of the Parallel Success series. Athletes with a UKA / INAS / BBS Classification can enter the Open competition *irrespective of where they live or were born*. Results from the event will be eligible for the Power of 10 and, where appropriate, IPC Rankings, including Paralympic Games qualification. Athletes who qualify for either Leicestershire & Rutland or Warwickshire will **automatically** be included in their County Championships as well.

How to Enter

Paper entries: The closing time is 10:00 on Friday 8th May 2015. There is a later closing date of 9th May 2015 at 21:59 if you use the online entry system. The entry fee is **£10 for each day up to a maximum of THREE** events entered for Parallel Success classified athletes. The address and payment details are on the paper entry form. Late entries and event changes after the closing date

The event policy is not to accept late entries or to make event alterations after the closing date. Please therefore ensure you bring your email or text confirmation to the competition with you.

Eligibility

To enter the Parallel Success events athletes will need a UKA or IPC Classification – including INAS-FID and BBS. Disabled athletes without a classification, but living or born in the respective Counties, can still be entered in the County Championships via these entry procedures.

Event cancellation and refunds

The organisers may cancel an event if there are very few or no entries or if the athletes can be otherwise accommodated. If an event is cancelled then athletes will be informed beforehand and given a refund. Refunds will not be given for any other reason.

Confirmation of entry

The online entry system will confirm your entry and payment. The organisers will send you confirmation of a postal entry (but only if you provide a mobile or email address. **If you do not get this confirmation then your entry has not been accepted or you have mis-typed your e-mail address.** The competition organisers will also send you an email (if you have provided one) sometime between the closing date and the meeting to let you

know more details of the meeting including the precise timetable. This will also be available on each of the County websites: www.LRAA.org.uk (Leics & Rutland AA) and www.WarwickshireCountyAA.co.uk.

Awards

The Parallel Success events are promoted as an 'Open Competition' staged within the County Championships and athletes will receive Parallel Success participation medals. However no County Association medals will be awarded unless the athlete qualifies for entry under the birth or residence rules of either of the County Athletics Associations.

Photography

Jeremy Eastaugh, the event's official photographer, and his colleague will take pictures of all athletes which will be on sale on the day and later displayed on his website at www.coventry-event-photography.co.uk from where you can also purchase copies. If you wish to be excluded from the photographs on display please let the Meeting Manager know. If you see anybody acting inappropriately, with or without any form of photography equipment, please tell the nearest Technical Official immediately.

Available Events

Registration time is at least 45 minutes prior to your event. Weighing-in of personal field implements is at least 60 minutes before your event. Please note that a Final Timetable will be produced after the closing date and will be available on the County website. PLEASE CHECK THE DAY CAREFULLY AS THE AMBULANT SPRINTS ARE ON DIFFERENT DAYS FOR EACH GENDER.

Track: All ambulant athletes competing in the Open completion only will compete with mainstream non-disabled athletes and other PS ambulant athletes wherever possible. Athletes using wheelchairs are all entering the Open competition only and will compete in separate gender races.

Where heats are required for Parallel Success athletes these will be decided by 2014 – 2015 Season Best times. Lane draws will be randomly selected.

Field:

All field athletes will be given 6 trials.

Throwing Implements: It is assumed that all athletes will use appropriate weight implements as outlined in IPC rules for their age group. If a junior athlete wishes to throw a 'Senior / Open' weight implement, please ask the registration desk to ensure this is marked on the field card for your event (and check it when reporting to your event).
