THE FULL BRONTE 5 MILE ROAD RACE

Thursday 5th June 2014

Race HQ, Registration and Finish of the race is at Haworth Cricket Club. This is just off West Lane near the Old Sun Hotel. The Finish will be around the cricket field and it must be one of the most scenic finishes of a 5 mile road race in Haworth!

Things you need to know

- Private Car Park owners in Haworth clamp anything that doesn't move. If you are in one of the car parks check if you need to pay and display and make sure that you have a ticket that covers you for the duration
- The race is based at Haworth Cricket Club and refreshments will be available from the club before and after the race
- The start will be at 7.30pm next to Rawdon Road opposite School (400 yards from the Cricket Ground)
- The finish is around the cricket ground
- It's a fairly hilly, two-lap course on the same route as previous years (see map)
- Prize-giving will be held in the Cricket Club as soon as possible after the race
- Trophies will be awarded to Yorkshire Vets in all the specified categories
- Prizes will be awarded to the first five male and female runners
- The course is accurately measured and all junctions will be marshalled
- Entries are accepted on the night, subject to entry limits not being reached – tell a friend or two, but pre-entry is essential if you wish to qualify for the Yorkshire Vets Championship
