Prestwich Challenge Charity Nomination

Background – why is financial support needed?

Nature of the proposal – what will the money pay for?

What is the outcome? How will the person or group be helped?

How much money is needed? (Is this a one-off, or an annual request?)

Guidelines:

- Preference is given to charities which are local to the club's catchment area, or where there is a connection to the club or its members
- Donations with a specific outcome which can be paid for in entirety are generally preferred to those which contribute to a larger charity fund.
- Donations should have a clear objective (e.g. to help someone with something they couldn't otherwise do or achieve, rather than just helping with financial hardship).
- Donations should not normally be for something that would be available via other means (e.g. to fund private health care treatment which would also be available on the NHS)

Process:

- Any club member may make a nomination.
- Club member should complete the nomination form and pass it to a committee member.
- Nominations will be considered by the Committee at the subsequent committee meeting.
- The committee will agree one of 5 outcomes:
 - Agree the nomination
 - Agree an alternative (e.g. to support the nomination but with a reduced amount of funding)
 - Request more information
 - Defer a decision (e.g. if the nomination is supported, but there are currently insufficient funds)
 - Decline to support the nomination.
